Discussion on state plan recommendations–

- Consider adding data that demonstrates the need
- Consider making short- and long-term recommendations
- Assess activity-level of current recovery coaches
- Develop a “picture” of what recovery system is going to look like (including goals and metrics)
- Add a recommendation to create a system for EDs to be connected to Recovery Coaches
- Add a recommendation for establishing Recovery Parenting Programs – for parents in recovery with children living at home
- Add a recommendation to implement SBIRT in EDs

Discussion on CoP and FO subcontracts –

- Why are there no organizations in Manchester? Not eligible, self-selected out, did not reply to 3 requests
- Harbor Homes offers to do the billing for subcontracted organizations
